MONUMENTAL SEVILLE

The tour begins between the whitewashed walls of the Santa Cruz neighbourhood, which will involve indescribable emotions; just around any corner can one feel the presence of relevant characters like Bécquer and D. Juan Tenorio. The Seville Cathedral is the largest Gothic and third-largest in the world. It was registered in 1987 by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site, along with the Alcázar palace complex and the General Archive of the Indies. The cathedral is also the burial site of Christopher Columbus.

The Alcazar of Seville is a royal palace in Seville, originally a Moorish fort. The palace is renowned as one of the most beautiful in Spain. The upper levels of the Alcazar are still used by the royal family, the official Seville residence, and are administered by the National Heritage. It is the oldest royal palace still in use in Europe, and it was registered in 1987 by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site.







MOSQUE OF CORDOBA

Guided Tour to the most outstanding monument of Cordoba, the Mosque-Cathedral. It has been declared World Heritage Site by UNESCO. We will continue to the old mosque built by Emir Abdurrahman I and the following expansions until the Almanzor period.


— Bienvenidos —— GRANADA

Granada has an unmistakably Moorish flavour, as it was the last city to be reconquered by the Catholic Monarchs in 1492. Gastronomy, craftwork and urban planning are influenced by its glorious past.

Fountains, viewpoints and "Cármenes", houses surrounded by typical gardens of this city, create unforgettable corners. It is no surprise that one of its historic districts, Albaicín, is a World Heritage Site with the Alhambra and Generalife.

MINI TRAIN CITY TOUR

Discover Granada at your own pace with the Granada City Train Hop-On, Hop-Off Tour. The tour allows you to discover the many attractions of this delightful city. You can choose a Hop-On, Hop-Off train ticket, valid for 24 hours or a ticket for one single journey. This extensive tour covers all the city's highlights in two great routes, one operating in the day and the other in the evening, and your ticket is valid for both routes.

The attractions covered include the Alhambra, the Albaicín district, the commercial city centre and the Realejo district.



FLAMENCO SHOW & DRINK

This venue offers a "zambra", a form of flamenco show that is danced in caves of the Sacromonte, the gypsy district (where some people still live!). Gypsies of the same family dance, sing and play a visceral flamenco whose roots date back to the times of the Moorish wedding dances in Granada. An additional attraction is a gorgeous view from the caves: the Alhambra and the Generalife by night.



ALHAMBRA & GENERALIFE GARDENS

Very few cities have such a dense history so well reflected in the many monuments, in its appearance and in the atmosphere of daily life. This tour offers a visit to Alhambra (13 - 15th Century), a fortified palatine city built by the Nasrid Dynasty, which also includes its Alcazaba Citadel and the Palaces of "Los Leones" and "Comares". The "Generalife" is a summer residence set in beautiful gardens. The so-called "Royal Room of Santo Domingo" was built in the orchards of Almaxarra. The Nasrid Queens used the Palace of Alcazar Genil. The Palace of Charles 5, designed in 1526 by Pedro Machuca in the heart of the Alhambra as a symbol of new power, is the most outstanding Renaissance work in Granada and possibly Spain.

- Regional and inter-regional trains are used for short distances and make frequent stops. They complement the long-distance services, connecting regional destinations with larger cities like Lisbon and Porto.
- InterCity trains connect all major towns and cities in Portugal. They are faster than regional trains and make fewer stops.
- Urbanos commuter trains operate in and around Portugal's largest cities, Lisbon and Porto.

Tourist Tax

All regions and cities impose a Tourist Tax. Amounts often vary between region and hotel star rating and often payable by customers locally on departure from their hotels. The tax is not included in the cost of the accommodation. It is an additional charge which must be paid directly to the hotel. The hotel will collect the tax on behalf of the local council. Payment

7. Force Majeure

We will not be liable or pay you compensation if our contractual obligations to you are affected by "unavoidable and extraordinary circumstances", meaning any event beyond our control, the consequences of which could not have been avoided even if all reasonable measures had been taken. 10. Our Liability to You

Where legal action is contemplated and you want our assistance you must obtain our written consent prior to commencement of proceedings. Our consent will be given subject to you undertaking to assign any costs or benefits received under any relevant insurance policy to ourselves. We limit the cost of our assistance to you or any member of your party to £5,000.
